La Tour is the largest private hospital group in the Canton of Geneva and comprises the Hôpital de La Tour, the Clinique de Carouge and the Centre Médical de Meyrin. The Hôpital de La Tour is the only private acute care facility in French-speaking Switzerland to offer a 24/7 emergency service, a ten-bed intensive care unit, a renal dialysis centre and a level IIA neonatal unit. A pioneer in embracing numerous innovations, and a hub for over 60 medical specialisations, each year the Groupe La Tour welcomes 7,000 inpatients and 300,000 outpatients including 40,000 emergencies, as well as performing 5,800 operations and training 40 doctors across seven medical disciplines. It employs 950 staff and has 350 registered doctors.

To guarantee integrated and personalised care to its patients and their families, its activities are organised into six healthcare pathways:

- Orthopaedics and sports medicine
- Oncology
- Metabolism and obesity
- Internal medicine
- Cardiology
- Woman and child

The La Tour group's facilities are recognised on the Canton of Geneva's hospital list and are also mandated to accept patients without additional private health insurance in certain specific cases. Outpatient services are available to all those with basic national health insurance (LAMal and LAA).

Hirslanden Clinique La Colline is located in the centre of Geneva and offers multidisciplinary medical and surgical care to both inpatients and outpatients.
