A Magnificent Natural Setting

The city overlooks the largest lake in Central Europe, with the stunning Alps in the background, and features rolling vineyards a mere ten minutes from the city centre. As the birthplace of the Red Cross, Geneva also harbours a great humanitarian tradition.

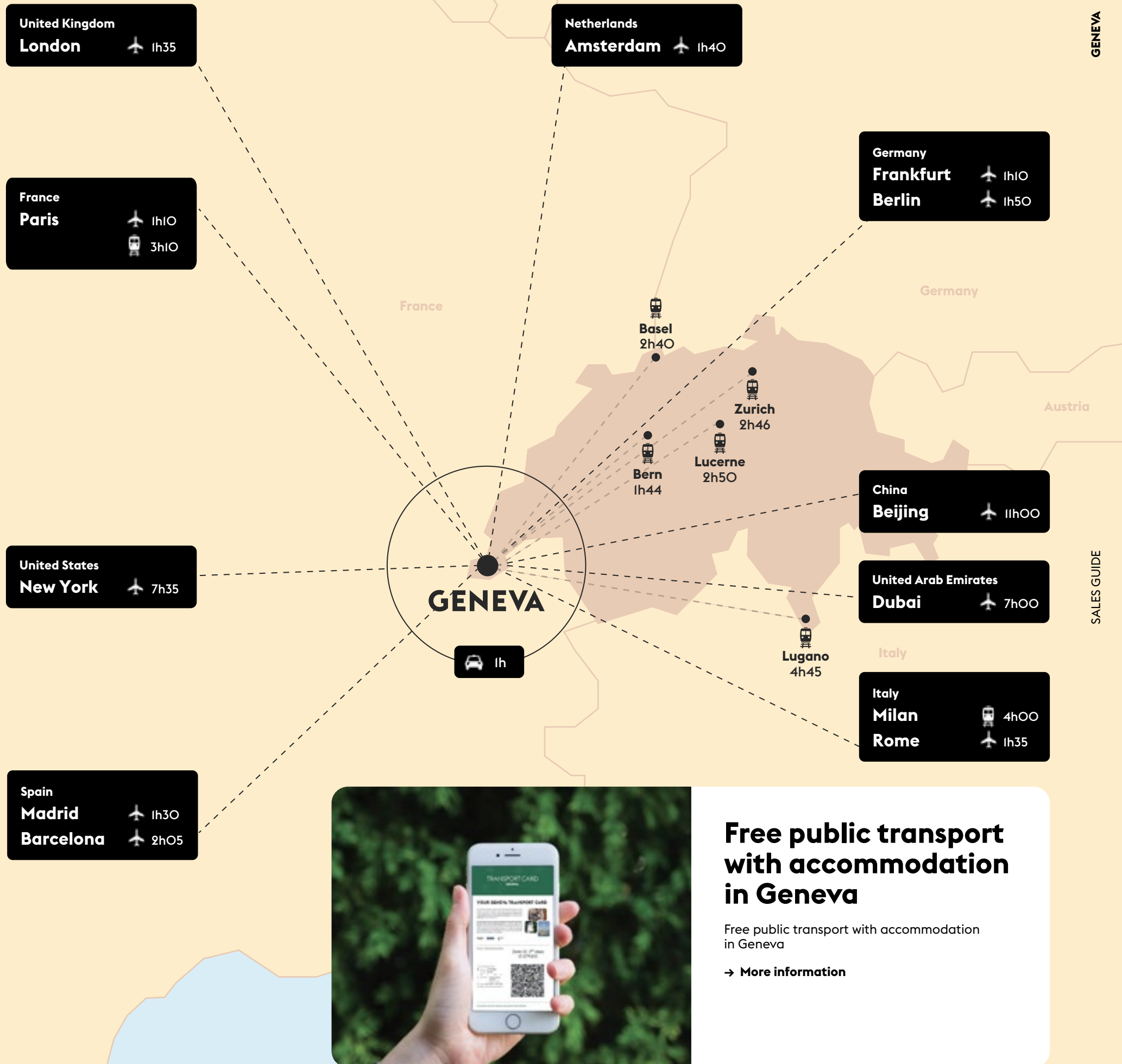

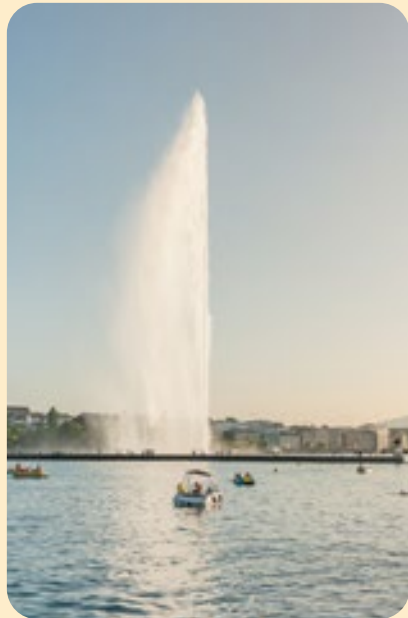

Geneva is set in a natural setting of pristine beauty. Nestled between Lake Geneva, the largest lake in Western Europe, and majestic mountains, including the Alps and Mont-Blanc, it is surrounded by endless countryside and vineyards. The charming city centre is dotted with swimming areas, beaches and flower-filled parks, providing an idyllic playground for all visitors in search of outdoor activities. THE CITY OF DIALOGUE

Known as the City of Dialogue, Geneva has been a central hub for multilateral diplomacy for centuries, hosting numerous visits by heads of state every year. The Nations district – the epicentre of International Geneva, known for its monumental Broken Chair sculpture – houses the UN European Headquarters as well as the head offices of 40 international organisations and more than 400 NGO's. Geneva, which is also known for its long-standing humanitarian tradition, is also a real multicultural hotchpotch, bringing together 189 nationalities of all creeds and faiths, who live together peacefully.

About 40% of the population consists of foreigners, and this international blend is reflected in the culinary scene, boasting around 160 types of cuisine.



The New Portail des Nations

The Portail des Nations, open in 2026, is a new 2,000 m² visitor center at the UN Geneva headquarters. It offers a multimedia experience on the UN's role, welcoming up to 250,000 visitors annually. In addition to the guided tours of Palais des Nations, the Visitor Centre, open 7 days a week, from 9 am to 6 pm, will offer an immersive experience dedicated to the multilateral role and the work of the United Nations in Geneva.

The International Museum of the Reformation

The International Museum of the Reformation (IMR) is housed in the prestigious 18th century Maison Mallet at Cour Saint-Pierre, the site of the former St Peter's Cloister. Thanks to a beautiful collection of items, paintings, books and manuscripts, this museum, created in 2005, recounts the reformation movement, which was one of the great religious movements in Christianity.

Geneva's first botanical gardens were created in 1817 as an expression of the then prevailing naturalist trend. Today, the Botanical Gardens and Conservatory occupy roughly 28 hectares. The garden's herbarium - one of the world's largest - has six million samples. The gardens invite you on a journey into the botanical world.
