Top-10 reasons to consider Geneva as a family destination

1. City-life and nature combined

Geneva is a city surrounded by mountains, with a lake, two rivers, vineyards and forests – all alongside bustling restaurants, shops and hotels. A short bus-ride can take you to a forest complete with wild animals or tree lines adventures, to then bring you back for shops and gourmet snacks.

2. Family-friendly hotels

A big hotel base offers many family-friendly options: swimming pools, family suits, connecting rooms, playgrounds, playrooms, and what families in Geneva always adore: a free public transport ticket for your stay.

3. The lake is your playground

Geneva is located on a large lake in English known as “Lake Geneva”, although it’s official name is “Lac Lemman”. If you only did one thing in Geneva, it would be to go to the lake! There are lots of small cafes and ice-cream parlours dotted along the lakeshore, as well as the chance to see the famous Jet d’Eau! The lake is also where you will find the solar-powered little train, offering a unique way to tour the city.

4. Educational and fun

If you’re looking for educational sides of the trip, Geneva is your place with CERN, UN, the Red Cross, not to mention many museums. Visiting these places will generate many topics to discuss with your children.

5. Easy to get around and so many connections

When you stay in an accommodation in Geneva, you receive your digital “Geneva Transport Card” free of charge. Thanks to this digital card, public transport in Geneva is free for the full duration of your stay.

The whole canton is conveniently connected by trains and roads with many places in Switzerland and Vaud. These are places that wouldn’t be chosen for a more extended stay, but if you’re looking for day trips that will be fun for the whole family, you’ll have plenty to choose from: Saleve, Chamonix, Annecy, Nyon, Montreux, or even Lyon.

6. Year-round fun and festivities

One of the best things about Geneva is that all year-round there are festivals and events taking place across the city and the canton, with activities for all the family. Many museums provide workshops for kids and guided tours in English, so even if a rainy day messes up your outdoor plans, you will still be able to stay occupied (and dry!).

7. A feast of food

Finding restaurants that offer cuisine from every corner around the world is easy, as is finding people who speak your mother-tongue. So no matter when hunger strikes, you will be able to handle it, be it with your kids favourite food from home or having fun trying the famous Swiss cheese fondue.

8. Summer sports galore

Lac Lemman offers plenty of beaches with water sports and activities for all ages to try. From paddle boats to wakeboarding or just swimming in the lake itself at the Baby Plage, Bain de Paquis, Geneve Plage, or the brand new Plage des Eaux Vives. Summer in Geneva is glorious.

9. A winter wonderland

In winter, Geneva becomes a wonderland of sparkling lights and festive decorations. It is also the perfect base for your winter mountain adventures be it skiing, sledging, or snowshoeing. Buses and trains can easily take you to the snowiest of destinations. Ice-skating is also available in many places across the canton!

10. Safety first

Switzerland is in the top-10 of the safest countries on the planet. Geneva, apart from some pick-pocketing in certain areas, is much safer than most touristic cities. Many roads are closed to traffic, meaning walking with young children is calm and stress-free.

BOIS DE LA BÂTIE (BÂTIE WOODS)

A forest in the middle of the city.

The Bois de la Bâtie offers magnificent trips on 12 hectares of natural forest.

Since its creation in 1874, the wood and its oak trees have been a favourite spot for nature lovers. The park and its various sports and leisure amenities is very close to the Jonction district, where the rivers Rhône and Arve unite. The playground is the largest of all such installations in the city. The Bois de la Bâtie runs an animal park. In this role it contributes to the conservation of endangered species.

The Parc des Eaux-Vives is the natural continuation of the Parc la Grange, accessible through a gate at its foot. As one of Geneva's oldest parks, it offers a fantastic view of the lake. The green lawns and numerous old trees invite nature lovers to take a stroll.

A green oasis.

A few steps away from the Palais Wilson on the right side of the lake, the visitor can walk towards the Perle du Lac Park, on the way to the botanical gardens. Cyclists cycle, joggers jog and people stroll along the paths crossing this green oasis. The park was named Perle du Lac by the wife of its former owner, Rolex founder Hans Wilsdorf. And that's exactly what it is - a pearl! In summer, people relax in freely available deck chairs and enjoy a refreshing drink facing Mont-Blanc.
